

Faithful Kate (Long Bio)

The artists responsible for 'Faithful Kate' are Lee Brinn (Vocals, Guitars), John Houlihan (Bass), and Ron Thornburg (Drums). Kindred spirits, they've developed their bond (and sound) through a tried and true musical partnership spanning over four decades.

The nucleus of the band formed in Westfield MA., forty two years ago when Lee Brinn and John Houlihan were still in school. Along with their first drummer, they called themselves Endover and played cover music - mostly classic rock. In 1991, they, along with new drummer Ronald Thornburg, changed their name to Rockin' Horse for a time. Finally in 2018, after a 25 year break, they reformed under the moniker of Faithful Kate. They have a seasoned, classic rock sound and relish in it, as their music clearly states.

They developed their soulful up-tempo americana / classic rock style performing at music venues, bars, and private parties in and around their home in Chesapeake Virginia, North to MA, and South to NC.

The main songwriter of the group's americana rock influenced sound is lead singer/lead guitarist Lee Brinn. He shares the spotlight with co-writer and bass player John Houlihan. Completing the trio is drummer/ percussionist Ronald Thornburg.

All told, these three musicians combine nearly a lifetime of experience writing, performing, and producing together. Their influences include; Aerosmith, J Geils Band, Faces, Steely Dan, Grand Funk Railroad, The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, and The Who, just to name a few.
